The after dinner lecture will be given by Philip Crummy, who is the Director and principal archaeologist of the Colchester Archaeological Trust, on ***Recent Archaeological Work and Discoveries in Colchester***.

The outline of this tour was given at the AGM in November 2015. Accommodation is in single rooms, at the University of Essex, Colchester Campus. Members can check in from 14:00 hours to the reserved accommodation, which consists of en suite bedrooms. It is also possible to make tea and coffee in shared flat kitchens. The reception will commence at 19:00 hours followed by the private evening meal at 19:30 hours. The lecture will take place in a lecture theatre at approximately 21:00 hours.

After breakfast at the university, the group will make use of public transport to travel the two miles into Colchester, where we will meet our guide Philip Crummy. The walking tour will take in some of the remains and sites of excavations and will end up at the site of the exciting discovery of the Roman circus, to the south of Colchester. After lunch (not included), we will assemble at the entrance to the Castle Museum and enter as a group to view the extensive displays of Roman Colchester in the castle keep, which sits over the remains of the Roman temple. The tour will finish at about 17:00 hours.
